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“For ye are NOT under the Law, but under Grace.” Romans 6:14

Certainly as Christians we cannot be under both Law and Grace. If God is going to judge us under the Law, we must remember these solemn words: ***“Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.”***

Galatians 3:10

. And, where can we find the Child of God who loves God with undivided strength, undivided being, undivided intellect, an undivided affection, and his neighbor as himself? This is the great commandment, which is the very essence of the law, right?

The LORD Jesus Christ, lived this perfect life, but no other man or woman has or can. But because of the Good News of His FINISHED work we can enter into His rest and are perfected by the offering of His Body and the shedding of His Blood on the tree. Hebrews 10:14.

Christ, was under the law. Galatians 4:4. This One who was holy, harmless, undefiled and separate from sinners, was tested by the world, by the devil, and by God’s Holy Law. **He came not to destroy but to fulfill the law**

. He is the “fulfiller” of the Law and is in, indwells, every believer. Therefore, the “fulfiller” of the Law is in every Child of God. Colossians 1:27. Therefore there is, NOW, NO condemnation against them that are in Christ Jesus. Romans 8:1. The LORD Jesus Christ, the Righteous, proved Himself righteous by meeting all the demands of God’s holy law, which is the only adequate standard of righteousness. God’s law is the one perfect law. Christ, is the one perfect Man, the embodiment and exemplification of that perfect law.

Now, pay attention, if Christ, was under the law, and the Child of God is not under the law, then we do NOT live in the same dispensation as He did. He lived on this earth as the perfect God-man before the **middle-wall of partition between the Jew and the Gentile was broken down by His death** . This is one of the most important points that Children of God must observe in rightly dividing the Word of truth. 2 Timothy 2:15. The Apostle Paul was able to begin his ministry to Gentiles because the middle-wall was removed at Calvary.

When you read Matthew 23:1-3, you can understand why Christ instructed His disciples to observe the teachings of the scribes and Pharisees. It was because they sat in the “seat of Moses.” Ya-hweh Yahuwshua did not unseat those who sat in the seat of Moses, nor did He do away with that seat of Moses, while He was a Minister of the Circumcision, sent only to the House of Israel. Matthew 10:1-6. Romans 15:8. Matthew 15:22-27. It was while He was under the Law that He said to the lawyer who tempted Him, **“What is written in the law?”** Luke 10:26. HOWEVER, He put an end to Moses’ seat when He cried, **“It is finished”**. John 19:30. AND **“the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom”** . Matthew 27:51.

Remember that the Sermon on the Mount was delivered BEFORE the middle-wall of partition was broken down, and therefore while there is much in it for the Child of God as a member of The Mystery, The Body of Christ, it is a KINGDOM message. But the Fruit of the Spirit which is to be manifested by the Child of God who walks in the Spirit is the very same love, joy, meekness, temperance, long-suffering, gentleness and goodness DEMANDED in the Sermon on the Mount. Galatians 5:22-23.

Against such there is no law. Galatians 5:23. Why not? Because Love is the fulfilling of the law. Love worketh no ill to his neighbor. Love suffereth long and is kind. Love seeketh not her own. Love thinketh no evil. Romans 13:10. 1 Corinthians 13:4-13.

Love is not an attainment. You cannot earn Love. Love is a gift! Romans 5:5. However, after it is received, with Salvation, as a gift it can be cultivated.

So here is what we have, **“Now the end of the commandment is Love.”** 1 Timothy 1:5. AND **“Christ is the end of the law unto righteousness”**. Romans 10:4. So the imperative and superlative need is: Christ, and to know His Love; and

then we can love because He first loved us.

“And this is His commandment, that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as He gave us commandment.” 1 John 3:23.

Then the Child of God’s creed IS Christ! **And His Law is Love.**

It is interesting to observe in Romans 5:13, and in Galatians 5:23, the phrase ***“there is no law”*** used. Study these verses.

The Law of the Spirit of life in Christ, sets the believer free from the Law of sin and death. Romans 8:2. The Law of the Spirit of life is described in 2 Timothy 1:10. That same Divine Law enables the believer, The Child of God, member of the Body of Christ, to walk IN the Spirit and thus fulfill the righteousness of the law. Romans 8:4.

“But God forbid that I should glory save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.” Galatians 6:14.

In Ephesians 1:13 the Holy Spirit through the Apostle Paul declares that men are saved and sealed by hearing and BELIEVING the Word of Truth, the Gospel of your Salvation. Therefore, here, now, is declared unto you the Word of Truth, the Gospel of your Salvation: ***“that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures”***

1 Corinthians 15:3-4. BELIEVE today.
